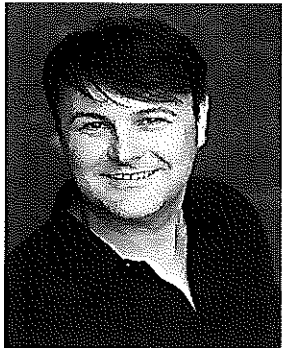

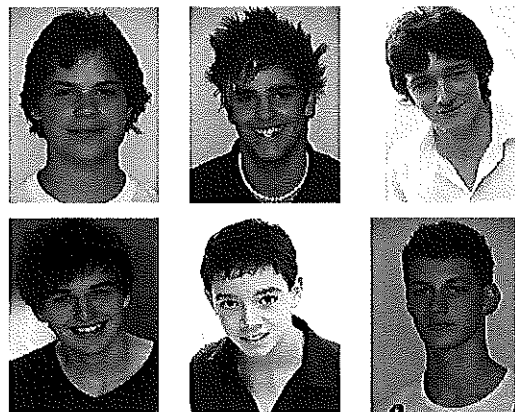

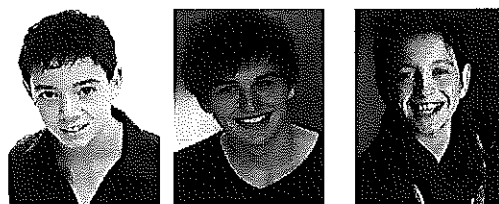
Adelaide Shores Campaign

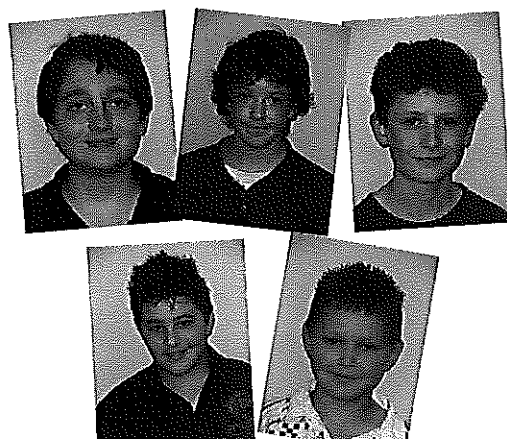
Frenimies
